2. CHECK OUT THE ADMISSIONS PROCESS and DATES AND DEADLINES at <http://admission.sewanee.edu/apply>
3. COMPLETE a **Common Application** on the Common Application's website. On this site, you can track the status of your application's completion. <https://www.commonapp.org/CommonApp/default.aspx>. There is no application fee associated with applying to Sewanee through the Common App.
2. COMPLETE Admissions Requirements:
  - A. SUBMIT official High School Transcripts through the Guidance Office.
  - B. CONSIDER SUBMITTING your official ACT or SAT scores. Please be sure to enter the Sewanee: The University of the South school code **(4024)** on your ACT application, should you choose to send your scores in. Sewanee is a testing-optional college and as such, should you choose not to submit your test scores, Sewanee requires an evaluative interview and an essay in lieu of score submission.   - C. TRACK your admissions status through your Common Application account.
5. APPLY for your PIN number (and parent's PIN number if needed) at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov).
6. COMPLETE the FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Student Aid) at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) .  
(Sewanee College Code: **003534**) **MUST BE COMPLETED BY JANUARY 15** for eligibility for some scholarships.
7. SEARCH Institutional Scholarships at <http://admission.sewanee.edu/apply/scholarships>. **APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIPS IS DUE ON DECEMBER 1.**
