 - A. SUBMIT official High School Transcripts through the Guidance Office.
 - B. SUBMIT a Housing Application with the standard UT – Martin application for admission.
 - C. LOOK OVER the Admissions Requirements as provided by the University of Tennessee, Martin:

 - D. SUBMIT a \$30.00 non-refundable application fee and \$100-150 refundable housing application deposit. Fee waivers for eligible students can be found on the NACAC website:

 - E. SUBMIT proof of a Measles or Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) vaccination to UTM.
 - F. SUBMIT your official ACT or SAT scores. Please be sure to enter the University of Tennessee, Martin school code **(4032)** on your ACT application.
 - G. CONSIDER applying for the Honors College at University of Tennessee, Martin. More information can be found here:

5. APPLY for your PIN number (and parent's PIN number if needed) at www.pin.ed.gov.
6. COMPLETE the FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov .
(UTM College Code: **003531**) **MUST BE COMPLETED BY JANUARY 15** for eligibility for some scholarships.
7. SEARCH Institutional Scholarships at http://www.utm.edu/departments/finaid/utm_scholarships.php. **Apply as soon as possible after January 1.**
