2. COMPLETE Admissions Requirements:
 - A. SUBMIT official High School Transcripts through the Guidance Office.
 - B. SUBMIT a \$40.00 non-refundable application fee. This can be paid through the Common Application website. Fee waivers for eligible students can be found on the NACAC website:

 - C. SUBMIT your official ACT or SAT scores. Please be sure to enter the University of Tennessee, Knoxville school code **(4026)** on your ACT application.
 - D. TRACK your admissions status through your Common Application account or by calling the Admissions office at (865) 974-2184.
 - E. CONSIDER applying for the Honors College at University of Tennessee, Knoxville. More information can be found here:

5. APPLY for your PIN number (and parent's PIN number if needed) at www.pin.ed.gov.
6. COMPLETE the FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov .
(UTK College Code: **003530**) **MUST BE COMPLETED BY JANUARY 15** for eligibility for some scholarships.
7. SEARCH Institutional Scholarships at <http://finaid.utk.edu/aid/scholarships/> **MOST DEADLINES are NOVEMBER 1ST**.
